Whitsun Camp 2010 – Important Information

We will be leaving the Urban Saints Hall (Stoke Park) at 6.45pm on Friday 28th May. If you are planning to travel to camp directly, please ensure that you inform Christopher Mansfield (07967 668 605) to prevent us waiting for anybody at the Urban Saints Hall unnecessarily. A map is on the reverse to show you the way - please note that the turn into and out of the site is quite difficult. It would be greatly appreciated if lads travelling independently could arrive at the site no later than 7.30pm. It would also be appreciated if any parents could help by providing lifts over to the site.

Camp will finish at around 5.00pm on Monday 31st May and we invite parents, brothers, sisters, friends, etc. to join us for tea from 4.30pm. It would be a great help if lads could be collected from the site by parents, to enable the leaders to clear the site. If, however, you are unable to do this please let Christopher Mansfield (07967 668 605) know before camp and we will arrange a lift.

Cakes:

Please bring some cake, biscuits, flap-jack, etc. if your mum or dad can manage this, or better still, make some yourself! – It is particularly nice to have with cocoa in the evenings. When you arrive at camp take this straight to the marquee and if you want to get your tin back, mark it with your name.

Pocket Money:

There is no need for pocket money as there will not be a tuck shop at Camp this year and there is no opportunity for lads to spend money.

Insurance:

We would remind parents that the class insurance does not offer personal property or personal accident cover.

Suggested Kit List:

Bedding – It can be quite cold at night, so a sleeping bag is unlikely to be sufficient - take a blanket and/or a camper-mat as well. Some lads like a pillow, but please no feather ones!

Waterproofs – You will need a waterproof anorak, although we hope it won't rain!

Footwear – Trainers are suitable for general wear, and an old pair should be brought for use in the river.

General – Jumper/sweatshirt, T-shirts, trousers, shorts, usual underclothes, pyjamas, swimming trunks and socks.

****Please note: A number of games involve water and water pistols appear a lot so bring plenty of spare clothes****

Miscellaneous – Knife, fork, spoon, mug, wash kit, insect repellent, sun block, torch, towels, bin liners (for dirty clothes), water pistol and Bible.

Don't bring your best clothes; they won't be best for long!

As far as possible your name should be on ALL items of kit. We strongly discourage all radios, CD players, etc. other than personal stereos. The site is not suitable for skateboards.

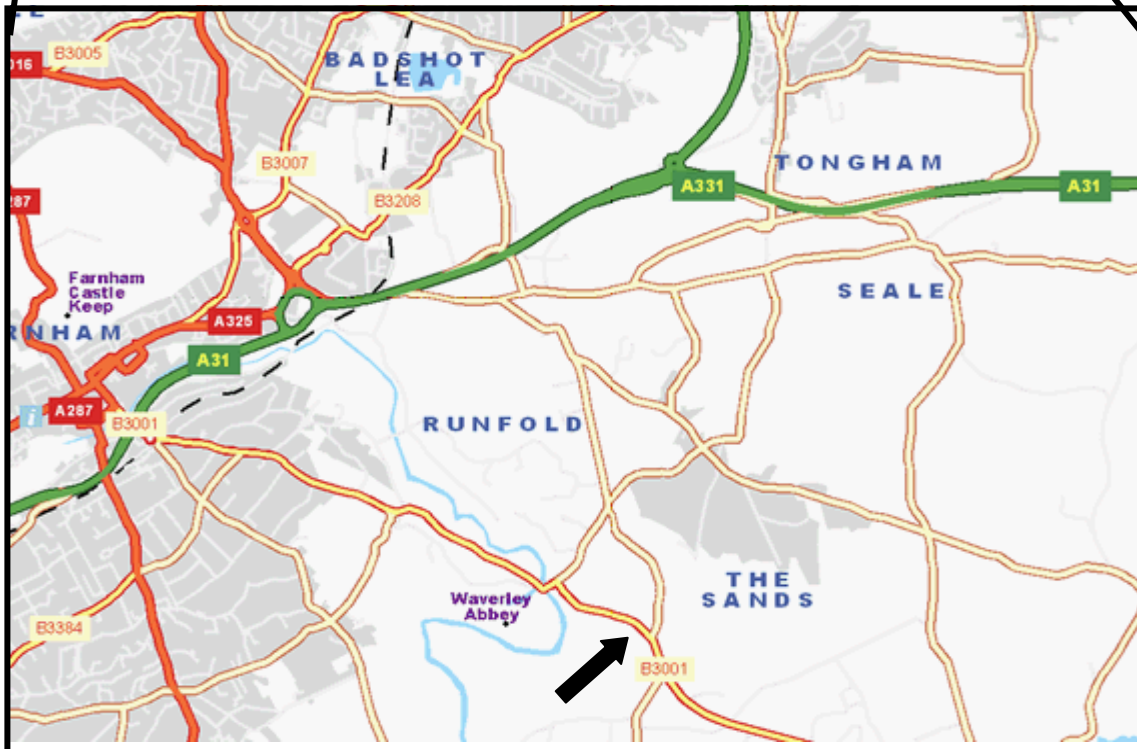
